

# EQUESTRIAN MANAGEMENT WORKSHOPS

## Howdy,

I am so glad that you will be attending and participating in an Equestrian Management Workshop. Please:

- Complete the registration form
- Download the waiver that the host site emailed to you and,
- Read the, “Preparing For and Attending an Equestrian Management Workshop” page or download. This will answer many of the questions you may have and give you an idea of what to expect and how to prepare.

The workshop is for certifying instructors with:

- Equestrian skills: haltering, leading, tacking, riding without assistance.
- Experience: basic handling and horse care.
- Knowledge: It is not a workshop to teach you basic horse skills and how to ride. Those lacking the skills, experience and knowledge may benefit from auditing the workshop but will not be able to be certified until sufficient skills, experience and knowledge are obtained.

**Please read the waiver pages carefully, sign and bring them with you to the workshop, minors will need the signatures of one guardian minimum, preferably both parents. You will be unable to participate without them.**

Classes begin on Sunday at 4:00 pm. Please arrive in sufficient time to begin. The schedule is very busy and requires concentration and effort. Work begins before breakfast and continues until 8:30 or 9:00 each evening with study time necessary after class each evening. Please make other arrangements for children, pets and media distractions, such as Cell phones.

Workshop Ends on Friday - after evaluations which are after lunch.

Some levels have a minimum age requirement.
